

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR UPDATE

"EXPANDING"...

Genesis 12:1 Now the Lord said to Abram,
"Go forth from your country,
And from your relatives
And from your father's house,
To the land wich I will show you;

We are EXPANDING the ministry of House of His Creation and stepping out in faith. We have been walking alongside women rescued from sexual exploitation for a number of years now and have helped open homes focused on those rescued from sexual exploitation. It is a horrible crisis in this world and there is NEED for more people to step forward and help restore lives.

In 2020 the decision was made to grow HoHC with two steps in mind. The first step was to sell the property in north Lititz and establish the maternity program of House of His Creation in a better location so the women could be better served in a community setting. That was accomplished in February of 2021.

Step two is establishing a therapeutic farm and family living environment to serve minors rescued from sexual exploitation. We have seen the trauma that years of abuse inflicts on victims. While there are a growing number of organizations providing safe housing for adult victims, their is a need for safe housing for minors rescued from sexual exploitation. We have prayerfully been exploring this calling and have not only felt that we are being called to open a new program, but that this program will be in a different state...

We have spent the better portion of the last 18 months researching locations that have a need for housing programs for minors and looking at the logistics of being a multi-state organization. We are calling the new housing program **685** (this is in reference to **Psalms 68:5** and the first part of verse 6) "A father of the fatherless and a judge and protector of the widows, Is God in His holy habitation. God makes a home for the lonely"

How do we get there? To start the Lititz
House will need **NEW** house parents. We firmly
believe that the next house parents live in Central
Pennsylvania. After house parents have been identified, the Neff family will move to the new location
to start the process of becoming certified to work
with minors and establishing the ministry in a new
state.

The bonus of the past two years is how versed we are at having virtual meetings and maintaining the organization. We are confident in the decision to multiply locations and staff.

The statistics on sexually exploited minors are heartbreaking. It is estimated that every day 13,000 minors are rescued, conversely there are 300-600 beds specifically for these victims. Programs are starting to open around the US to address this deficit of safe housing. Our goal is to have 8 beds available, for young women rescued from sexual exploitation, by Christmas of 2022.

We will be launching our monthly donor campaign for 2022. For monthly commitments of \$25.00 you will receive an H0HC t-shirt, monthly commitments of \$50.00 or more per month you will receive an HoHC Yeti tumbler and \$75.00 or more per month will receive a t-shirt and a tumbler. We hope to FRIENDRAISE for this growth! Please share this with your friends, small groups, churches and businesses. We are looking to greatly increase financial support in order to launch the **685** program successfully!
